Landfill Disposals Tax Bill

Thank you for your letter dated 8 July 2016. We discussed the Landfill Disposal Tax Bill ('the Bill') at our meeting on 14 July.

Whilst we did not arrive at a final view on how we want to consider the Bill, I can report that we have the capacity to consider the Bill, should the Business Committee decide to remit it to us for consideration.

It appears to us that the Finance Committee would be the appropriate committee to consider the Bill. As it is involved in scrutinising another Bill, we can see the case for referral to either the External Affairs and Additional Legislation Committee or this Committee as it addresses policy areas within our remit.

We will want to consider the policy detail of the Landfill Disposal Tax Bill to make sure it contains no perverse incentives which are contrary to the Well-being of Future Generations (Wales) Act 2015 and the Environment (Wales) Act 2016.

I trust this information will be of use to you and the Business Committee when determining the remittance of this Bill for committee scrutiny.
