Re: Health and Social Care Committee - Inquiry into the availability of bariatric services

I write on behalf of Mr. Simon Dean, Chief Executive for Velindre NHS Trust in response to the invitation to offer comment on the above consultation.

Velindre NHS Trust is a nationally recognised specialist centre of excellence for the provision of non-surgical oncology including radiotherapy and chemotherapy; specialist palliative care; blood transfusion; specialist immunohaematology; antenatal blood testing reference work; and transplant immunology.

The consultation has been distributed widely across Velindre Trust, and I am pleased to provide the following comments –

- During the last year there has been 1 occasion when there was a requirement to provide a bariatric bed and chair for an in-patient.
- We had prior notification from the referring organisation that the patient required a bariatric bed; we were able to hire a bed and chair within 4 hours and receive timely training for use of the equipment by the company.
- We have hoisting equipment which can be used for patients who need bariatric equipment.
